

**Economics 272-3: Third Year Literature Review  
Fall 2002**

Economics 272-3, the Third Year Literature Review, Paper and Presentation, is meant to help students find a dissertation topic and begin their research. The course will meet periodically throughout the quarter as indicated below, on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10:30-11:50 a.m. in Room 300, with the first meeting Thursday, September 26.

The course has four requirements, with deadlines as follows. No incompletes will be given.

**A. Topics and readings:**

Week 2, Tuesday Oct. 8, 4 p.m.: You must submit a proposed topic and a preliminary list of papers to be reviewed. **Students should discuss their ideas with their interim supervisors beforehand,** and then submit the topic and list to both Professors Betts and Crawford by email.

**B. 20-minute preliminary presentations (sign-up for a time slot in the first meeting):**

Week 4, Tuesday and Thursday, Oct. 22 and 24

Week 5, Tuesday and Thursday, Oct. 29 and 31

**C. 30-minute final presentations (sign-up up for a time slot in first meeting):**

Week 7, Thursday, Nov. 14

Week 8, Tuesday and Thursday, Nov. 19 and 21

Week 9, Tuesday, Nov. 26 (Nov. 28 is Thanksgiving)

Week 10, Tuesday and Thursday, Dec. 3 and 5

**D. Paper:**

The paper is due at the beginning of class on Thursday, Dec. 5. There is a 5% reduction in grade for every day the paper is late up to Friday Dec. 13, including the weekend.
